This conference dedicated to the imaginative universe(s) of Joss Whedon—the Jossverse(s) or Whedonverse(s)—will be held on the campus of Flagler College in Saint Augustine, Florida, June 6-8, 2010. Drs. Tamara and James Wilson of Flagler's Department of English will be local arrangements chairs.

We welcome a proposal of 200-300 words (or an abstract of a completed paper) on any aspect of *Buffy the Vampire Slayer*, *Angel*, *Firefly*, *Serenity*, *Dr. Horrible's Sing-Along Blog*, *Dollhouse*, his comics (e.g. *Fray*, *Astonishing X-Men*, *Runaways*, *Buffy the Vampire Slayer Season Eight*), or any element of the work of Whedon and his collaborators. We invite presentations from the perspective of any discipline: literature, history, communications, film and television studies, women's studies, philosophy, religion, linguistics, music, cultural studies, and others. Discussions of the text, the social context, the audience, the producers, the production, and more are all appropriate. All proposals/abstracts should demonstrate familiarity with already-published scholarship in the field, which includes over a score of books and, of course, eight years of *Slayage*.

Papers are limited to a maximum reading time of 20 minutes.
